

# Campground Guidelines

Welcome to Cross Creek, the following regulations are intended to provide all of our guests with a pleasant camping experience.

- **Office / Camp store:** See posted hours
- **Checkout time is 12 pm.**
- **Visitors:** Are asked to check in with the office and will be directed where to park, any use of facilities is \$5.00 per person.
- **Quiet Time is 11 pm. To 7 am.** If your sound travels through your site and into another, it is TOO LOUD. Children need to be back at your campsite by quiet time.
- **No Public display of Alcohol or Drunkenness:** Please keep alcohol in a Koozie or plastic cup.
- **Speed Limit is 5 mph** in park and 15 mph on main gravel road.
- **Pet Policy:** Leash Law in effect in campground, carry a bag with you when walking pet, If they Poop you Scoop! Do not leave pet unattended at campsite, they miss you and may bark too much. Please no pets in public buildings.
- **Fires:** Keep fires to a safe size, NO Trash, Cans, Bottles or Plastic burned! Firewood for sale at office, please don't drag up huge logs from the woods or cut my trees!  
(\$\$ Fine/Surcharge will apply)
- **Sewer Ring or Connector:** Required by Law on all RV's.
- **Smokers:** Please keep your BUTTS off the grounds. Use trash can in your camping unit. **NO smoking or vaping in the Cabins** or \$100 smoke removal fee will apply.
- **Trash:** Please place trash in tied plastic bags and place in the nearest covered BLUE container.
- **Fisherman:** Leave the lake cleaner than you found it; remove your trash and fishing line. **Do NOT** leave fish on stringer over night, Turtles & Raccoons will eat your fish.
- **Trails:** several trails are around made by fellow campers, watch your step.
- **Boat Rental:** See office for fees; please **stay off** boats unless you have paid for one.
